

Terms and Conditions

1. Event Title, Date

ASYS Group Technology Days 2026 from October 21-22, 2026.

2. Organizer

ASYS Automatisierungssysteme GmbH, hereinafter also referred to as „organizer“.

3. Scope

These terms and conditions apply to the participation at the event as specified under number 1. By registering for this event, the participant accepts these terms and conditions and their exclusive validity.

4. Registration

The organizer will confirm the registration by e-mail latest after the registration deadline. Submission of the registration does not entitle the participant to participate. Participants are only allowed to enter the event with a valid written confirmation. The organizer reserves the right to reject registrations without cause.

5. Cancellation of Event or Program Items

The organizer has the right to cancel the event in total or single program items (e.g. expert presentations, etc.), especially if there is only a small number of registrations. A claim for damages is excluded. This also applies in the event of short-term cancellations of program items or the cancellation of the complete event, even if a notification of the participants in advance is not possible anymore.

6. Instructions / Conduct

a) For the duration of the event, the participants must obey the instructions of the organizer, his legal representatives and his employees. For your safety and the safety of others, please follow these instructions carefully.

b) The participant must refrain from any actions that could hinder or endanger other participants, representatives of the organizer or other persons. The participant must behave appropriately during the event.

7. Exclusion from Participation

The organizer is entitled to exclude individual participants from further participation anytime (e.g. disturbance of the event and the course of operations).

8. Pictures of the Event; Pictures of Participants

a) The taking of photographs or film recordings during the event is only permitted for private use. Any commercial use of such material requires the prior written consent of the organizer.

b) During the event, the organizer is entitled to produce photographic or film material on which the participants may be recognizable, and to use and publish this material for the purposes of documentation, for accompanying or subsequent reporting, for the subsequent marketing of this event and for public relations work incl. the hand over to third parties (e.g. the press) for the aforementioned purposes, without any claim to remuneration.

9. Data Protection and Storage

By registering, the participant agrees that his personal data may be stored and processed by the organizer. The participant agrees that a list of participants with surname, first name and company may be passed on to the invited expert speakers and to other participants of the event. Your personal data will neither be published by the organizer nor passed on to third parties without authorization.

10. Liability

Liability of the organizer for damages of the participants for any legal reason - including delay, impossibility, defective performance and non-contractual (tortious) liability - is excluded, unless for gross negligence or intention or where it is required by law. The organizer is not liable for damages caused by viruses on copied data carriers. Data carriers brought in by participants may not be uploaded to the organizer's computers or network. The organizer reserves the right to claim damages for such violations. The organizer is not liable for theft.
