

# Visiting Swissmedic Practical Information



### How to get to Switzerland and Bern



Switzerland can be reached by air, rail or road within a few hours from all major European cities. Berne is well integrated into the Swiss travel system and connected to all major Swiss cities and airports.



Arriving by air	Switzerland has three major airports which are served by numerous international airlines:
	<ul> <li>Zurich Airport</li> <li>Geneva Airport</li> <li>Basel Mulhouse Airport</li> </ul>
	The airports of Zurich and Geneva are connected to the Swiss railway network and have their own stations. From Basel airport, there is a shuttle bus to the city centre (15 to 20 minutes). The shuttle stops directly in front of Basel's main train station. Intercity trains to Berne run hourly from all cities.

# Your accommodation in Berne



Your accommodation has been booked at the *ibis Styles Bern City* located approx. 15 min from Swissmedic HQ.

- 1. Leave Bern main train station from the exit on the eastern side.
- 2. Take the bus no. 10 towards Schliern
- 3. Get off at bus stop "Eigerplatz"
- 4. From there, the hotel is only a one-minute walk away:



## How to reach Swissmedic Headquarters

#### Shuttle bus

Kindly note that a transfer service from/to the hotel has been arranged. The shuttle bus will follow this schedule:

Monday:

- Departure from Hotel to Swissmedic: at 08:15
- Departure from Swissmedic to Hotel: at 17:45

Tuesday:

- Departure from Hotel to Swissmedic: at 09:00
- No return shuttle to Hotel --> Social Event after end of day

Wednesday and Thursday:

- Departure from Hotel to Swissmedic: at 08:30
- Departure from Swissmedic to Hotel: at 16:45

Friday:

- Departure from Hotel to Swissmedic: at 08:30
- No return shuttle to Hotel --> City Tour after end of training

Please note that the bus driver has been instructed to wait max 7 min after the scheduled departure time, so you are kindly advised to be ready on time.

#### Alternatively, by public transportation:

- From the Hotel, walk to the nearby bus station "Eigerplatz".
- From there, take the bus no. 10 towards "Ostermundigen" and get out at the bus station "Bahnhof" (main station).
- From there you can reach our Headquarters by bus no. 20 towards Länggasse.
- Get off at bus stop "Universität".
- From the bus stop it's a 1 min walk

Currency	Switzerland is not part of the European Union. The national currency is the Swiss franc (CHF).

Electricity	The voltage in Switzerland, as in most of Europe, is 230V/50 Hz. Switzerland uses type C (2-pin) and type J (3-pin) plugs. (Type C 2-pin plugs also fit J sockets.)	
	Most power sockets are designed for three pin round plugs. The standard continental type plug with two round pins, applied for many electrical travel products, may be used	
	without problem. To be sure to use your electrical equipment, please take an adaptor with you.

Time Zone	During the winter, Central European Time (CET) applies in Switzerland. From the end of March to the end of October, <b>Summer Time applies (CET + 1 hour)</b> .	
Weather	The climate is moderate with no excessive heat, cold or humidity. From July to August the daytime temperature range is 18 to 28 °C ( $65^{\circ} - 82^{\circ}$ F) and from January to February the range is -2 to 7 °C ( $28^{\circ} - 45^{\circ}$ F). In spring and autumn, the daytime temperature range is 8 to 15 °C ( $46^{\circ} - 59^{\circ}$ F).
