The Olympic Museum, Quai d'Ouchy 1, 1006 Lausanne



Opening times :

Open Tuesday to Sunday from 9 am to 6 pm.

Closed on Mondays (except Easter Monday or for special events).

Closed on December 24th, 25th and 31th and on January 1st.

For corporate events, we open at special times, upon request and reservation.

By car from Geneva or Yverdon (A1), follow the signs for “Lausanne-Sud”, then the motorway exit, at the roundabout, take the first exit on avenue de Rhodanie in the direction of “Lausanne-Maladière/Vevey”. Continue to Ouchy, park your vehicle and walk to The Olympic Museum.

By car from Montreux (A9), take the “Belmont/Lutry” exit and go down to the lake. In Lutry, head in the direction of Lausanne on the right, continue to Ouchy, park your vehicle and walk to The Olympic Museum.

We advise you to park in the **Port d’Ouchy car park**, located 8 minutes’ walk from The Olympic Museum.

Public parking spaces – payable from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., 7 days a week – are also available along the quai d’Ouchy, below The Museum (3 hours maximum). Coaches can park in the five special spaces – free of charge – located next to the Olympic fountains on the quai d’Ouchy.

Those with reduced mobility are advised to arrive by the north entrance, located on avenue de l’Élysée 34. Please notify us of your presence at the barrier so that our security staff can let you enter. Depending on the availability of spaces and upon presentation of a disability badge, you will be authorised to leave behind your vehicle during your visit/event.

Deliveries must be made through our north entrance, on avenue de l’Élysée 34. Please notify us of your presence at the barrier so that our security staff can let you enter. You will be directed to our loading bay where you can leave the merchandise.

By train, from Lausanne train station, take the M2 metro, direction “Ouchy-Olympique”, until the stop of the same name. On exiting the metro, turn left (past the Château d’Ouchy) and walk along the lake (about five minutes) to “place Jacques Rogge” (the Olympic fountains). Climb the steps through the park and you will arrive at the main entrance of The Olympic Museum.

By bus, take line 2 to the Ouchy-Olympique stop; line 8 to the Musée Olympique stop; line 24 to the Parc Musée Olympique stop or line 4 to the Montchoisi stop. Depending on where you are, you can enter The Olympic Museum via the north entrance (avenue de l’Élysée 34) or the main entrance (quai d’Ouchy 1).

By metro (M2), get off at the final stop, “Ouchy-Olympique”. On exiting the metro, turn left (past the Château d’Ouchy) and walk along the lake (about five minutes) to “place Jacques Rogge” (the Olympic fountains). Climb the steps through the park and you will arrive at the main entrance of The Olympic Museum.
