# What data do we collect?

We may process personal data about you as part of event management. The personal data we process may include, among others, the following:

- Contact information: First name, last name, email, company, role, category.
- Images, audio recordings, and videos of you.
- Billing data and payment information, if payment is required.
- Case ID, Case Owner, Salesforce Contact ID, if you register via a mobile.de account.

This information is collected directly from you or through your registered mobile.de account when accepting the event invitation.

#### How and why do we use your personal data?

We have established the following purposes for processing your personal data:

# How long will your personal data be retained?

Your personal data will only be retained for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, and subsequently, while blocked for other purposes, for as long as necessary to fulfill legal or contractual obligations.

# To whom will your data be forwarded?

For the provision of "event management services", we use the third-party provider "Evenito", which acts as a "processor" for mobile according to Art. 28 GDPR. In providing the services, it may be necessary to transfer data to Switzerland. For Switzerland, there is an adequacy decision pursuant to Art. 45(1) GDPR, according to which the European Commission has determined an adequate level of protection for the processing of personal data in this country.

# What rights do you have regarding your personal data?
